Operating alongside the quarry, the waste and resources facility has been designed to the highest planning and environmental standards.

Leachate and Water Protection

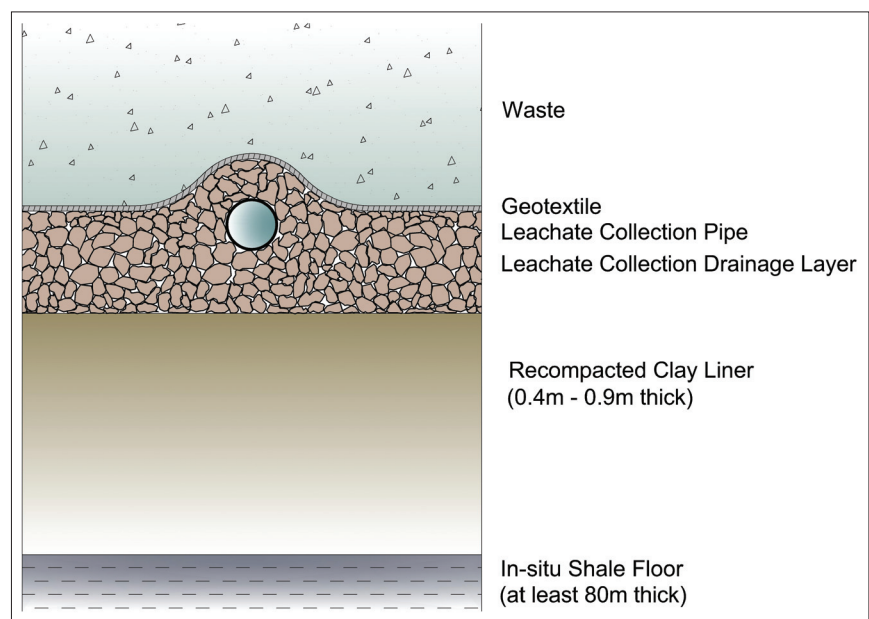
The nature of waste (Commercial and Industrial and Construction and Demolition) being treated and deposited at the Orchard Hills Waste & Resource Management Facility will ensure that generation of leachate will be kept at an absolute minimum.

As a safeguard to our surrounding environment and consistent with industry best practice, leachate pipes will be integrated across the entire facility, allowing for the safe and secure collection of any liquid matter produced.

Designed to the highest industry and regulatory standards, the base of the landfill will comprise a low permeable layer of compacted clay, outperforming strict regulatory standards. The walls of the facility will be covered in High-density Polyethylene (HDPE) landfill liner.

Together, these measures will provide strong long term environmental safeguards protecting the water table and surrounding landscape.

Every measure is being put in place to provide maximum protection to the surrounding water table.

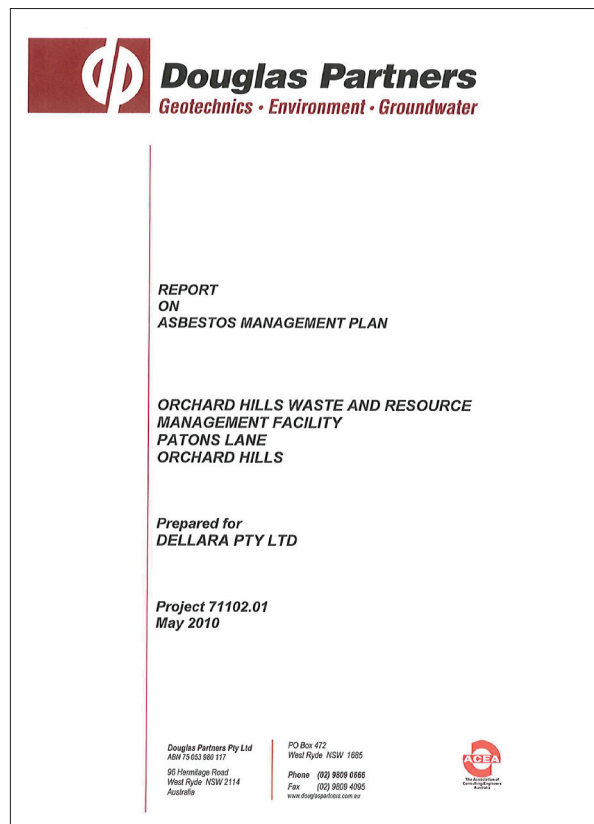


Asbestos Management Plan

Dellara in consultation with Penrith City Council are working towards a sustainable solution which will mitigate the pre-existing onsite waste, including asbestos contaminated materials which were **illegally** dumped on site by the **previous owner**.

We have commissioned a comprehensive Asbestos Management Plan, developed to the highest regulatory standards, which will ensure the safe removal and secure disposal of the waste on site, containing elevated concentrations of asbestos.

We expect the site clean-up to commence prior to the end of 2010.
