Re: Champions Quarry – Project Approval Modification No.3

Thank you for your email dated 6 June 2017 about the Champions Quarry Project Approval Modification No.3 seeking comments from the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH). I appreciate the opportunity to provide input.


The OEH has statutory responsibilities relating to biodiversity (including threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats), Aboriginal and historic heritage, National Parks and Wildlife Service estate, flooding and estuary management.

We have reviewed the relevant parts of the Environmental Assessment and can advise that we have no concerns with the proposed modification that relate to OEH's statutory responsibilities.

We re-iterate the importance of ensuring that the proposed actions are consistent with the intent of the *Aboriginal Burial Management Plan* and the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management Plan*, listed under Item 3 of the Project's Statement of Commitments, which were to be developed to guide project compliance with the Conditions of Approval (specifically Conditions 34 to 36).
