


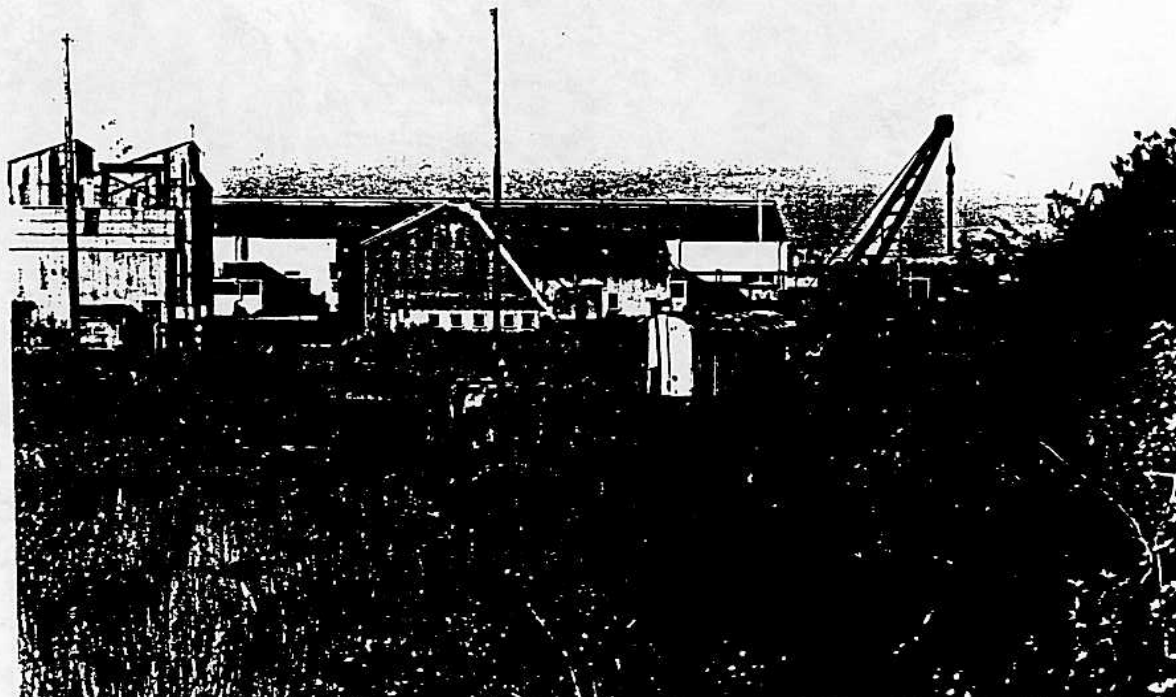

<p>Description: Coal Stage - This dump supplies the three steam cranes. It is located adjacent to the track and has a concrete floor raised about 800mm above the track to facilitate loading. Two sides and the back of the dump are surrounded by a 1.5m high wall of recycled sheets of 7mm mild steel.</p>

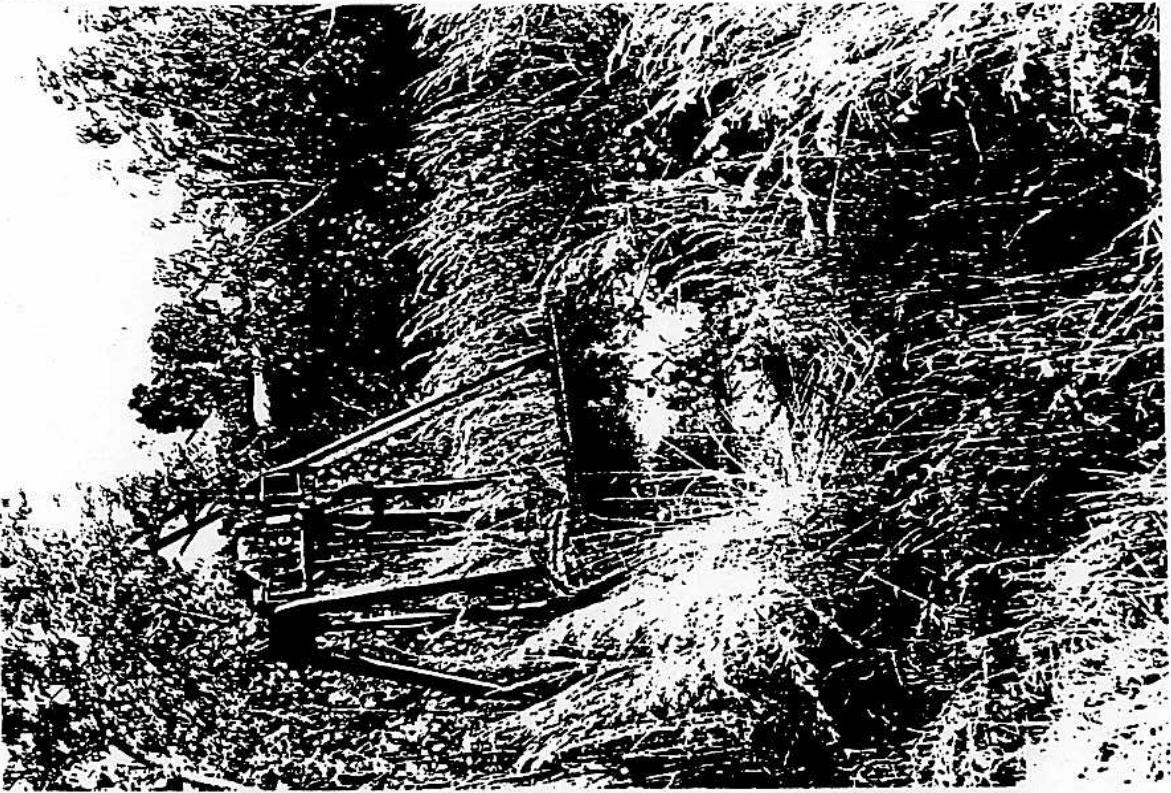

<p>Description: P1010 - GRAFTON ENGINEERS BEDFORD - No's on 542, 362. CRANE No. 2151. 361 on Base. A grafton steam crane with its beam intact. The beam is raised and lowered by twin tension rods with pulleys at the base end, around which the raising chains pass. The crane is not operational but is similar to crane 1 in most respects. If anything, more of the original fabric is evident on this machine.</p>

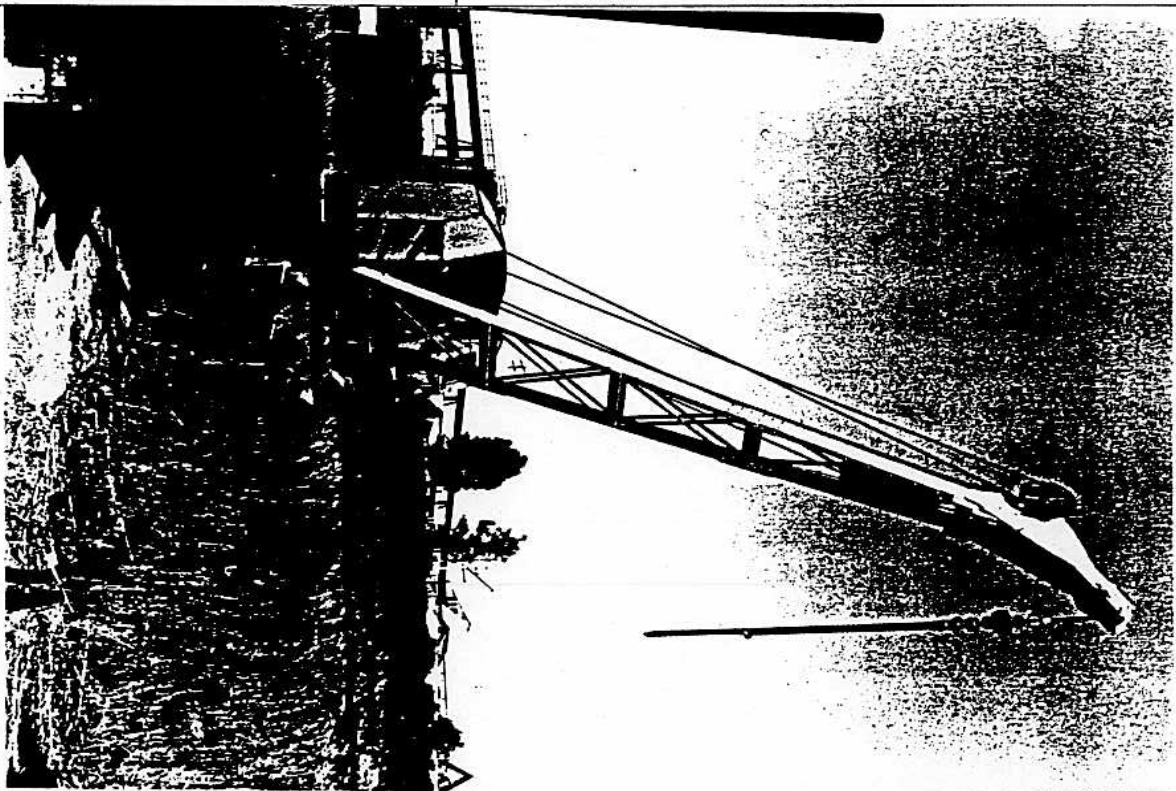

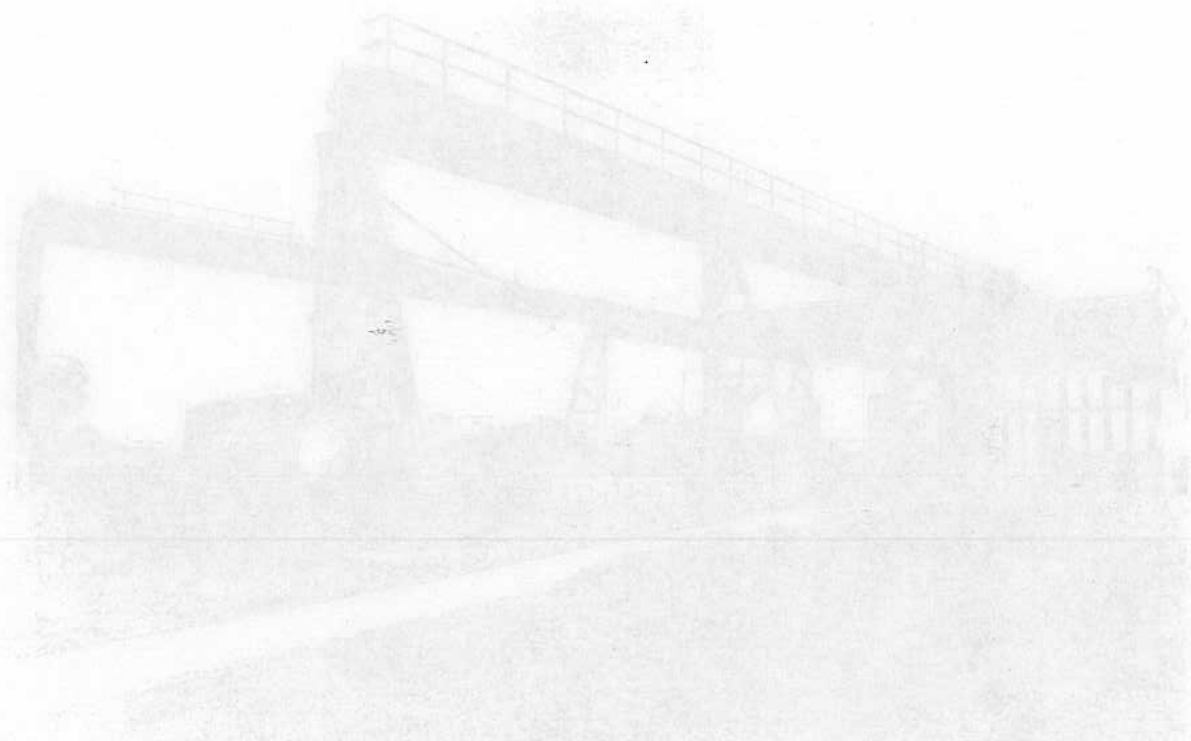
