





Description: The air raid shelters are brick walled, reinforced concrete roofed purpose built structures. The initial design included walls approximately 300mm thick and roof 200mm thick and did not include any windows. The shelters have been used for storage purposes since World War II and have been altered accordingly. New penetrations have been made in the walls and double wooden doors now allow easy access of goods. These shelters were inaccessible but identical shelters on other parts of the site have also had internal walls removed. The original layout of the air raid shelters is shown below. The toilets located beside the entrance have also been removed in most cases. The shelters are approximately 13 metres long x 4.5 metres wide.


