Reference is made to your letter dated 27 September 2010 regarding the subject major project application forwarded to the Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) for consideration.

The RTA has reviewed the submitted information and does not object to the project in principle as it is considered that traffic generated by the project will not have a significant impact on the classified road network.

In accordance with Section 79C(1)(b) of the EP&A Act, the Department of Planning is responsible to consider any likely impacts on the natural or built environment in the road reserve fronting this proposed development. For instance there could be traffic noise impacts on adjacent residences, impacts on indigenous or non-indigenous heritage items or threatened species. The RTA will not be making a separate Part 5 environmental assessment of the environmental impacts in the road reserve for this proposal.
