Notice of an application for modification of a State significant
development consent granted under Part 4 of the Environmental
Planning and Assessment Act 1979

An application has been made to the Minister for Planning by Werris Creek Coal Pty Ltd (ABN 69 107 169 102), a wholly owned subsidiary of Whitehaven Coal Limited (Whitehaven), for consent for the Werris Creek Coal Mine Final Landform Modification (the Modification) under Section 4.55, Part 4 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (EP&A Act). The Modification seeks approval to amend the final landform and rehabilitation strategy to support the closure and rehabilitation of the site.

Whitehaven gives notice of the application for consent to carry out the Modification under Part 4 of the EP&A Act in accordance with clause 98 of the Environmental Planning Assessment Regulation 2021.

Site Description: The Werris Creek Coal Mine is an open cut coal mining operation that has been operating since 2005, with the open cut overlying and intersecting the former Werris Creek Colliery, a bordand-pillar underground mine that operated from 1925 to 1963. The Werris Creek Coal Mine is located approximately 4 kilometres (km) south of Werris Creek in the Liverpool Plains Local Government Area (LGA). The Modification is proposing to modify PA 10_0059 to authorise changes to the final landform and rehabilitation strategy to include retention of a final void, development of a permanent pit lake, change in the post-mining land use within the final void and additional compensatory vegetation areas adjacent to the mine site.

The application was accompanied by a Modification Report prepared for the Modification in accordance with the level of environmental assessment and community engagement required to satisfy the Department of Planning and Environment. The application and Modification Report will be made publicly available by the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment.
