Description of project

Kimbriki Environmental Enterprises (Kimbriki) is seeking concept (MP 10_0064) and project (MP 10_0065) approval to construct and operate two alternative waste treatment facilities at the existing Kimbriki Resource Recovery Centre site at Terry Hills. The proposal includes:

- a resource recovery facility (RRF) - using alternative waste technology (including tunnel composting) to receive and process up to 100,000 tonnes per annum of mixed municipal solid waste and source separated food and organics;
- a materials recovery facility (MRF) - to receive and process up to 60,000 tonnes per annum of dry recyclable materials; and
- associated infrastructure.
