## Hi Craig,

Elizabeth Cala passed on your email to me. I have had a quick look at the proposed washout procedure. I have no problems with the process for cleaning out the trucks or managing the concrete solids. However, the procedure states that up to 30000L of water will be required, and states that excess water will be pumped out of the skips prior to removal "as per the WMP". I am not sure that I have seen a WMP to know where this will go. The report should state where this potentially contaminated water will be disposed of. The report should note that Skips should be pumped dry enough that no residual water will escape from the skips during transport.
