**ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR CENTRAL COAST CANCER CENTRE
GOSFORD (MP I0_0173) PROJECT**

Dear Mr McManus,

I refer to your letter dated 26 November 2010 regarding the invitation to the RTA to comment on the subject Environmental Assessment.

The RTA has noted that the proposal seeks approval for the construction of an integrated cancer centre at Gosford Hospital, to be known as the Central Coast Cancer Centre. The project is subject to Part 3A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. The Minister for Planning is the approval authority for the project. Health Infrastructure has submitted an Environmental Assessment for the above project.

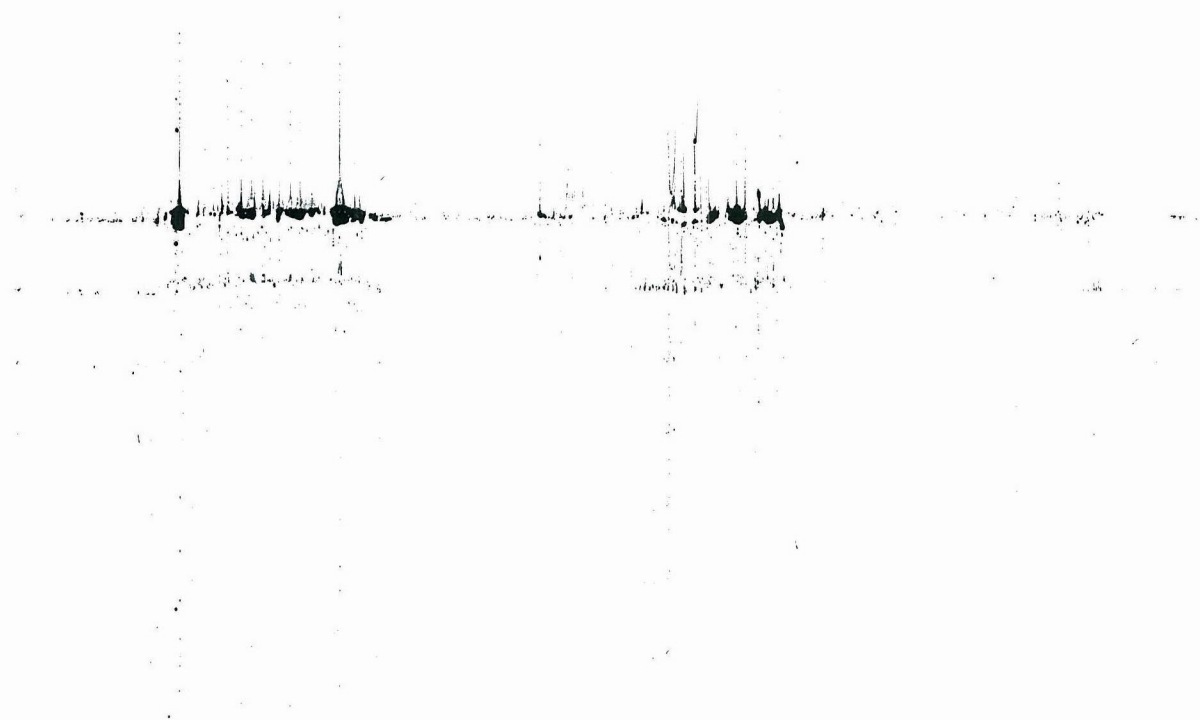
In accordance with the *Roads Act 1993*, the RTA has powers in relation to road works, traffic control facilities, connections to roads and other works on the classified road network. RTA concurrence is required for works and structures in, on, under or over these roads under section 138 of the Act.

Your previous correspondence dated 13 October 2010 requested the views of the RTA on the draft Director Generals Requirements with details of additional key issues and assessment requirements. This advice was forwarded to you on the 5 November 2010.

The RTA has reviewed the information provided in the subject Environmental Assessment and noted that the following issues raised in my previous advice of the 5 December 2010 were not adequately addressed.

- The identification of existing pedestrian and cycling movements servicing the facility and the assessment identifying existing public transport usage and infrastructure.

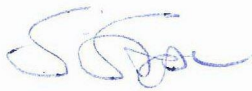


- The identification of all intersections effected by the proposed development as well as undertake a detailed intersection analysis of these intersections. Identify measures to mitigate potential impacts.

The developer is to be advised that conditions of consent determined by the Minister do not guarantee the RTA's final consent under the *Roads Act 1993* to the specific roadwork, traffic control facilities and other structures works on the classified road network.
