EL 6162: Approval to Undertake Category 3 Exploration Activity

In accordance with Condition 2 of EL 6162 granted under the provisions of the *Mining Act 1992*, the titleholder is hereby granted approval to conduct the Hera Project Bulk Sample, subject to the conditions set out below. These conditions relate specifically to this approval. The conditions are in addition to those previously attached to EL 6162 and prevail to the extent of any inconsistency. A breach of these conditions is an offence under the *Mining Act 1992*.

CONDITIONS

General

1. The works must be carried out at the location(s) and in accordance with the methods contained in:
 - Review of Environmental Factors for the Exploration Decline at the Hera Deposit within Exploration Licence 6162 Via Nymagee December 2006; and
 - Addendum to the Review of Environmental Factors for the Exploration Decline at the Hera Deposit within Exploration Licence 6162 via Nymagee.

Except as amended by the following conditions.

Security

2. Works must not commence until additional security has been lodged with the NSW Department of Primary Industries (NSW DPI). The amount of security required under this condition will be advised by the Titles Branch of NSW DPI.

Other

3. A variation to the Mining Operations Plan for the site of the ore processing is to be submitted to NSW DPI and accepted prior to transporting of the ore from the Hera site.
4. A Traffic Management Plan must be submitted to and accepted by Cobar Shire Council Council prior to hauling any ore from the Hera exploration decline through the town of Cobar.

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5. Should any Aboriginal object or non-Aboriginal object with significant heritage value be found on the site during the proposed works, the works must cease and the proponent must notify the Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC).
6. The proponent shall monitor noise and vibration resulting from blasting and institute controls, generally in accordance with the recommendations of Australian Standards AS-2187 - 1993 and ANZECC "Technical Basis for Guidelines to Minimise Annoyance Due to Blasting Overpressure and Ground Vibration (1990)".
7. Copies of the 6 monthly reports described on page 3-16 of the Exploration Decline at the Hera Deposit REF dated December 2006 must be provided to NSW DPI for review.
8. The Licence Holder must implement all practicable measures to prevent and/or minimise any harm to the environment that may result from the construction, operation or rehabilitation of any exploration activities.
9. The Licence Holder must report any incidents causing or threatening material harm to the environment to both DEC and DPI in accordance with Departmental guidelines.

For the purposes of this condition, harm to the environment is material if:

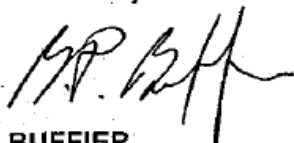
- (i) it involves actual or potential harm to the health or safety of human beings or to ecosystems that is not trivial, or
- (ii) it results in actual or potential loss or property damage of an amount, or amounts in aggregate, exceeding \$10,000.

Loss includes the reasonable costs and expenses that would be incurred in taking all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent, mitigate or make good harm to the environment.

10. The Licence Holder must lodge an Environmental Management Report (EMR) with the Director-General with any renewal application, at the expiry of the licence, or at dates otherwise directed by the Director-General. The EMR must be prepared in accordance with Departmental guidelines to the satisfaction of the Director-General.
11. Additional environmental reports may be required from time to time by the Director-General and must be lodged by the Licence Holder as instructed.
