Subject: FBB proposal to amend DP&E MCOA - C6

Hi Michael,

Further to our discussion this morning regarding Fulton Hogan's proposal to amend the Ministers Conditions of Approval in relation to works outside of standard construction hours, I confirm the following:

- FH are hoping to apply to DP&E for amendment to Condition C4 (e) and removal of Condition C6 as highlighted below.
- We are proposing that these conditions be replaced by inclusion of words to the following effect in lieu of C4(e) "*where an Environment Protection Licence applies to the construction of the project, the approved construction hours, and any associated conditions / requirements, as set out in the Environment Protection Licence*". We are aware that DP&E has incorporated this same wording into other recent Part 3A approved projects.
- This proposal does not impact on the protections afforded to potentially affected noise receivers and in no way affects our commitment or requirement to comply with the Project Environment Protection Licence 20462, specifically conditions relating to L4 "Hours of Operation";
- In relation to any works that FH are required to perform outside of standard construction hours as directed by RMS and/or for reasons supported by Section 2.3 of the Interim Construction Noise Guidelines, FH will always seek to consult with and obtain agreement from potentially affected noise sensitive receivers in accordance with Conditions L4.4 and L4.5;
- The Department of Planning & Environment Conditions C4 and C6 are replicated below, with FH proposal against each FYI:
