LANDSCAPE PHILOSOPHY

- (A) THE ENTRY TO THE SITE IS MARKED BY TWO LARGE TREES WITH LOW PLANTING UNDER PERMITTING CLEAR VISION TO THE ENTRY AREA.
- (B) THE ENTRY AREA IS HIGHLIGHTED WITH A CONTRASTING PAVER AND IS UNCLUTTERED TO ENSURE CLEAR ACCESS TO THE FRONT FOYER
- (C) THE OUTDOOR CAFE AREA CREATES A SOFT AMBIENT SPACE DEFINED BY GARDEN BEDS WITH LOW PLANTING AND OFFERS AMENITY TO STAFF, PATIENTS AND VISITORS.
- (D) THE COURTYARD SPACES OFFER AN ALTERNATIVE SPACE FOR CONSULTATIONS IN A MORE RELAXED SETTING OR FOR COMMUNITY OUTDOOR FUNCTIONS AND BREAK OUT FROM THE MEETING ROOMS.
- (E) THE STREET PARKING INCLUDES HIGH CANOPIED TREES PROMOTING CLEAR VISION THROUGH THE AREA AND FOR SHADE.
- (F) THE SECONDARY ENTRANCE IS HIGHLIGHTED WITH CONTRASTING PAVING THAT MATCHES THE COLOR OF THE INTERNAL PAVER FOR A SEAMLESS TRANSITION
- (G) THE EXISTING WALKWAY FROM GRIFFITH BASE HOSPITAL MEETS THE SECONDARY ENTRY.
- (H) THE SERVICES AREAS ARE DESIGNED TO BE UNCLUTTERED AND INCLUDE HARD WEARING CONCRETE SURFACES.
- (I) THE VIEW FROM WITHIN THE COURTYARD EXTENDS THROUGH THIS AREA SO THE SURFACE MATERIALS ARE DESIGNED TO CREATE A SEAMLESS TRANSITION BETWEEN BOTH SPACES YET ENSURE THE OUTSIDE AREA IS FUNCTIONAL AS A SERVICE AREA.
- (J) THE COURTYARD IS DESIGNED TO OFFER A VARIETY OF SPACES FOR INDIVIDUAL AND SMALL OR LARGE GROUPS TO CONGREGATE ON ARTIFICIAL TURF AND PAVED AREAS. LOW PLANTING GARDEN BEDS ARE LOCATED ON THE SIDE OF THE BEDROOMS TO PROVIDE A SOFT BUFFER BETWEEN THE SPACES AS WELL AS ENSURING PATIENT PRIVACY. COLOURFUL VEGETATION BEDS DEFINING SPACES FURTHER AND THE COURTYARD INCLUDES TWO FOCAL POINTS WHICH COULD BE LOCAL ART OR A FIXED STATUE.
- (K) THIS SPACE IS DESIGNED TO BE VIEWED FROM ALL AREAS BUT NOT INCLUDE PEOPLE USING THE AREA. THE SPACE HOLDS A GREEN CARPET-LIKE TURF TO REFLECT SERENITY FROM THE TRAPPED EXTERIOR INTO THE INTERIOR CIRCULATION. FEATURE SCULPTURES AT FOCAL POINTS ARE LOCATED ALLOWING TO CAPTURE THE SPACE AS ONE WALKS BY IT.
- (L) THE HEALING GARDEN IS DESIGNED TO OFFER A VARIETY OF SPACES THEMED WITH THE OTHER COURTYARD TO PROVIDE A CONSISTENT LANDSCAPE CHARACTER FOR THE HOSPITAL. THE GARDEN'S PATH IS DESIGNED TO ALLOW FOR AN INTERNAL-EXTERNAL EXPERIENCE OF THE SPACE USING THE MULTIPLE POINTS OF ENTRY AND EXIT BETWEEN THE GARDEN AND THE BUILDING.
- (M) THE PLANTING ALONG THE RETAINING WALL WILL EVENTUALLY COVER THE WALL TO SOFTEN THE VISUAL IMPACT OF THE CAR PARK AND STREETScape AS WELL AS COLLECT AND DISCHARGE STORMWATER RUNOFF.
- (N) THE PLANTING TO THE STREET PROVIDES CLEAR VISION THROUGH THE CAR PARK AND SOFTENING THE VISUAL IMPACT OF ANIMO AVENUE ON THE SITE.
