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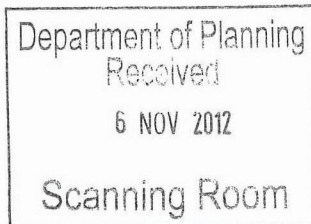

Concrete Recyclers (Group) Pty Ltd has lodged a major project application and environmental assessment (EA) under Part 3A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* for the St Peters Materials Recycling Facility, located in the City of Sydney and Marrickville local government areas.

Concrete Recyclers (Group) Pty Ltd proposes to construct and operate a materials recycling facility in St Peters. The project involves:

- processing the existing sandstone stockpile on site;
- processing up to 150,000 tonnes of sandstone waste per annum; and
