I am emailing you in regarding my opposition to the above mentioned proposal.

I am the owner of 19 Campbell Rd, St Peters.

We are already living with fumes and dust from the local landfill in St Peters. If this new proposal goes through, this will just make this situation worse.

One of our main concerns is the impact all this added outdoor activity will have on the quality of the air we breathe and general health.

The crushing of sandstone creates fine particles of dust which are a major health issue, potentially causing lung disease such as silicosis.

Sydney Park is just across the road, approx 30 metres from the boundary of the proposed recycling plant. Hundreds of people exercise and enjoy the park every week.

The high volume of trucks coming through the area creates added danger as some of our streets and lanes are very narrow.

The movement caused by the trucks driving through the area also spreads the dust and dust particles even more.

We currently have a lot of intermittent truck/traffic movements during the day. This proposal will greatly increase the noise and dirt levels.

I am also concerned about the noise which would be generated by the machinery used during the recycling/crushing process. We currently **do not** have any constant noise from machinery such as generators, heavy vehicles moving soil, beeping from reversing machinery, etc which I anticipate would be part of the above operation. The noise that we currently have is intermittent traffic noise.

**This is my home.**

I grow vegetables, have chickens, care for my friends children and dogs, have bbqs and live a reasonably quiet life here.

The proposed site for the recycling facility is just 4 metres from my back fence.

If this proposal goes through we may be forced to take legal action as I can no longer live in an area that is hazardous to my health. The local residents in the area have been meeting regularly to stop the Landfill and any developments in regards to concrete, earthworks, recycling and etc because of the impacts it has on our quality of life and running of businesses in the area, we are all definitely opposed to this proposed development.
