Advice on Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for SSD – 10468, Warehouse and Customer Fulfilment Centre, Marrickville

Thank you for referring the EIS for the above State Significant Development (SSD) to Heritage NSW for comment. We understand this SSD relates to the proposed Warehouse and Customer Fulfillment Centre at Lot 202 in DP 1133999, Lot 3 in DP 318232 and Lot 3 in DP 180969, commonly known as 74 Edinburgh Road, Marrickville, New South Wales.

Review of Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment (ACHA) 74 Edinburgh Road, Marrickville 14 October 2020

We note the ACHA is a working draft only and as such does not supply the information required for Heritage NSW review. The information supplied in the EIS is therefore also incomplete. Heritage NSW requests that when the ACHA is completed (this is indicated in the EIS to be expected to be finalised by December 2020), the EIS needs to be updated to reflect the findings of the ACHA and both documents should be referred to us for review at this time.

We look forward to reviewing the EIS and ACHA once they have been completed.
