Liverpool Range Wind Farm Modification 3 – Revised BDAR Addendum

Thank you for your email request dated 22 June 2026 to the Conservation Programs, Heritage and Regulation Group (CPHR) of the NSW Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (NSW DCCEEW) inviting comments on the Response to Submissions report for Modification 3 of the Liverpool Range Wind Farm (SSD-6696-Mod-3).

We have reviewed the Addendum Report against the recommendations made in our response dated 30 April 2026 (DOC26/209920-19). The report should be updated to include figures identifying:

- areas within the proposed easement not surveyed due to access constraints
- areas of proposed partial loss
- areas likely to be avoided through spanning, mapping these areas as polygons rather than point data to clearly delineate impact extent.

We support increasing the verification period for partial loss areas from three to six months, subject to preparation of a partial clearing monitoring strategy that verifies extent and condition in line with Tables 6.7 and 6.8 in the Biodiversity Development Assessment Report. A condition of approval similar to that used for the Hunter Transmission Project would be appropriate.

The Renewable Energy Biodiversity Support team will continue engaging with Tilt on the proposed staging of the Biodiversity Management Plan and retirement of biodiversity credits.
