Thank you for your referral seeking advice for the above State Significant Development Response to Submissions. Thank you for the continued opportunity to comment on the project.

The responses provided by Umwelt dated June 2026 have adequately addressed most of the comments provided by Heritage NSW on Aboriginal cultural heritage matters related to the above State Significant Development. Heritage NSW advises The Department to require the proponent to address the following two outstanding issues:

1. To demonstrate that the current modification documentation and Amended Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment (AACHA) has been provided for consultation with all the RAPs, please provide Heritage NSW copies of the emails with all relevant email addresses shown and all replies received. Noting that the emails provided in Section B.5 of the AACHA do not show recipient addresses and none of the RAP responses listed in Section 3 of the AACHA are provided.
2. Heritage NSW advises that the AHIMS record for Quindalup 2 (AHIMS ID 28-6-0021) needs to be updated to reflect the tree is no longer present and the site is no longer valid.
