**ASH RECYCLING FACILITY AT ERARING POWER STATION- SSD MODIFICATIONS  
(MP07\_0084-MOD-2) - EOTH21-00300**

I refer to your invitation for Subsidence Advisory NSW (Subsidence Advisory) to provide comment on modifications and additions to and ash recycling facility at Eraring Power Station.

It is understood that the proposal allows for the construction of three (3) x 450t storage silos and four (4) x 600t storage silos. The application also includes other associated infrastructure such as crib (lunch) room facilities and water storage tanks.

Centennial Coal have made an application to carry out coal extraction within proximity of the proposal (ref - SSD-10333, PAE-28549501).

An EIS accompanying Centennial Coal's proposal indicates that the site could be subject to mine subsidence ground movements. The mine subsidence impacts outlined in Centennial Coal's proposal are slight and could be mitigated against by engineered design.

Given the above Subsidence Advisory has no objection to the proposal.

It is however recommended that the applicant consult with Subsidence Advisory prior to carrying out a detailed engineered design of the project elements outlined in the proposal.
