**WANGI ROAD (MR217) & AWABA ROAD (MR220): MP07_0084 – MOD 2, S4.55
MODIFICATION, ERARING POWER STATION**

I refer to the request by the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) dated 23 September 2021 seeking input from Transport for NSW (TfNSW) to the S4.55 Modification for the abovementioned development proposal.

TfNSW key interests are the safety and efficiency of the transport network, the needs of our customers and the integration of land use and transport in accordance with the *Future Transport Strategy 2056*.

Wangi Road / Dora Street / Mandalong Road / Macquarie Street (MR217) and Awaba Road / Cessnock Road (MR220) are classified State roads. Rocky Point Road, Construction Road and Wilton Road are local roads. Council is the roads authority for both roads and all other public roads in the area, in accordance with Section 7 of the *Roads Act 1993*.

TfNSW has reviewed the referred information and provides the following comments to assist the consent authority in making a determination:

- A safety assessment needs to be carried out concerning the additional heavy vehicle movements turning right from Wilton Rd onto Wangi Rd.


Advice to DPIE

- It is recommended that inbound heavy traffic movements from the south be avoided during the PM peak times due to congestion being experienced through the Morisset Town Centre.
