Extraction Plan for Bulli Seam Operations - Appin Mine Long Walls 709-711 and 905

Thank you for your correspondence dated 28 October 2021 providing the opportunity to make comment on the extraction plan for Bulli Seam Operations - Appin Mine Long Walls 709-711 and 905.

The NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) Agriculture is committed to the protection and growth of agricultural industries, and the land and resources upon which these industries depend.

DPI Agriculture has reviewed the documentation provided with the extraction plan which is a requirement of the development consent for the mine (MP 08_0150).

It is noted that the extraction plan has included details of the proposed management, mitigation, monitoring and reporting of potential impacts and environmental consequences of the approved underground mining operations at Appin Mine. This process will include the preparation of a Property Subsidence Management Plan (PSMP) for individual landowners. The PSMPs will be developed in consultation with the individual property owners prior to subsidence effects at the property and will address the management of all surface infrastructure including rural buildings and farm dams and development of any mitigation measures.

DPI Agriculture has no further requirements for the extraction plan.
