## Modification Application DA-318-12-2004 Mod 4 for Extension to Allied Pinnacle Flour and Maize Mill, 330 Picton Road, Maldon

Thank you for your correspondence dated 30 November 2021 providing the opportunity to make comment on Modification 4 to development consent DA-318-12-2004 for extension to the Allied Pinnacle Flour and Maize Mill at 330 Picton Road, Maldon.

The NSW Department of Primary Industries (DPI) Agriculture is committed to the protection and growth of agricultural industries, and the land and resources upon which these industries depend.

DPI Agriculture has reviewed the documentation provided with the application and considered the nature of the proposed development.

I note that the proposed development comprises an extension of the existing mill building for warehousing, office and amenities and establishment of circulation, ingredient holding and de-packaging room, a test kitchen and pre-weigh room and a complex mix room, within the existing building. I note the proposed development is on land zoned IN3 Heavy Industrial.

DPI Biosecurity and Food Safety has advised that the proponent will need to comply with the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code and all applicable parts of the Food Act 2003.
