PH Penrith Operations Pty Ltd – Proposed Modification to Glass Recycling Volume (SSD-5267-Mod-3)

Thank you for your request for advice received on 7 December 2021, requesting the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) review and comment on the Modification Application and Report in respect of proposed modification to the glass recycling volume at PH Penrith Operations Pty Ltd (SSD-5267-Mod-3) at 126 Andrews Road, Penrith NSW 2740 (Premises).

The EPA has reviewed the 'Scoping Report for Modification of SSD-5267' prepared by Build Run Repair and understands the proposal involves an increase to the volume of material processed annually at the Premises.

The EPA is aware of extensive refurbishment works at the Premises over the previous 12 months and considers that the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposal have been adequately assessed and that the environmental management measures currently in place at the Premises are appropriate. As such the EPA has no objection to the proposed modification.

PH Penrith Operations Pty Ltd, holds Environment Protection Licence No. 20381 to carry out the scheduled activities of resource recovery and waste storage at the Premises under the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997.

It is recommended that the applicant contact the EPA directly in relation to any variations to their Environment Protection Licence that may be required should the modification of consent be approved.
