EPA Advice on Submissions Report – Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project

Thank you for the request for advice from Public Authority Consultation (PAE - 39009969), requesting that the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) review of the Submissions Report for the Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project (Application SSD - 12469087) at 715 Brayton Road Marulan NSW 2579. I apologise for the delay in responding and appreciate the extension of time granted to submit the EPA's response.

The EPA has reviewed the following documents:

Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project, Submissions Report - EMM Consulting Pty Ltd - March 2022

The EPA understands that the proposal is to increase the tonnage of saleable products dispatched from the Quarry, with a commensurate increase in truck movements along local roads.

The EPA has reviewed the Submissions Report and notes the proponents commitment to apply to vary the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 13012) if the proposal is granted approval. The EPA reiterates its advice that was also provided to the proponent in the EPA's letter dated 9 November 2021, that upon approval of the Continuation Project, supporting information must be provided to the EPA. The supporting information must demonstrate how the premises will receive and manage up to 50,000 tonnes of cured concrete waste per annum, along with the environmental controls that will be implemented in regard to this material, the storage location(s), tonnage verification and record keeping.

The EPA has no further comments or recommendations on the proposal.
