Advice on Modification 14 SWDF increase, Delivery Variation & Site Access, Boral Cement, Berrima.

Thank you for your referral dated 11/4/2022 requesting comment on the abovementioned major project modification.

The proponent's documentation has assessed the Project and determined it would not involve the removal of native vegetation and therefore not trigger the need for any offset requirements. As such, the proponent has requested a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR) waiver, pursuant to s.7.9 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*.

The Biodiversity Conservation Division has responsibility for preparing BDAR waivers. There is no statutory timeframe for determining these, however we will aim to respond within 28 days.
