EPA Advice on Modification Report

Dear Brittany

Thank you for the Public Authority Consultation (PAE-42984346) notification to the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) about proposed modifications to the approvals granted to Tronox Mining Australia Limited (Tronox) for the Atlas-Campaspe Mine (SSD-5012 Mod 3), Snapper Mine (MP06_0168 Mod 8) Ginko Mine (DA251-09-01 Mod 15) and Broken Hill MSP (DA345-11-01 Mod 8).

The EPA has reviewed the following documents:

1. Murray Darling Basin Operations, Short term ore transport and processing modifications - Modification Report – April 2022.

The EPA understands the proposal is:

- The transport of ore from the Atlas-Campaspe Mine to other Tronox facilities in their Murray Darling Basin Operations.
- The short-term processing of the ore through existing Tronox processing facilities.

Based on the information provided the modification proposes changes to approved transport routes and no change to activities at EPA licensed sites or environmental impacts at those sites.

The modification activities do not appear to require a variation to any environment protection licences held by Tronox. We have no further comments on the proposed modification.
