**Subject:** Blind Creek Solar Farm – Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) exhibition.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide advice on the above matter. This is a response from the Department of Regional NSW – Mining, Exploration & Geoscience (MEG) – Geological Survey of NSW (GSNSW).

MEG-GSNSW note that the project site is located within an area that has been producing construction sand supplying the Canberra market over a long period of time. The EIS acknowledges Bungendore Sands Quarry is located approximately 250m south-west of the project site and the Paragalli Sands Quarry is approximately 500m east of the site. MEG-GSNSW recommends ongoing consultation with the quarry operators throughout the life of the project to minimise the impacts to their operations.

MEG would appreciate the opportunity for early consultation in relation to the proposed location of any biodiversity offset areas (should they be required) or any supplementary biodiversity measures to ensure there is no consequent reduction in access to prospective land for mineral exploration, or potential for sterilisation of mineral or extractive resources.
