Re: Advice on Additional Information – Kings Park Metal Recovery and Recycling Facility Expansion (SSD-10396)

Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) acknowledge correspondence received on the 24 June 2022, requesting advice on additional information for Kings Park Metal Recovery and Recycling Facility Expansion (SSD-10396). FRNSW have reviewed the Main Response Report along with previous correspondence received by FRNSW on this matter.

FRNSW note the issue “Noting the Stockpile Plan has been described as an 'end of day' plan, please liaise with FRNSW regarding fire vehicle access and manoeuvrability during active operational hours.” It is further noted in Sell & Parker letter to FRNSW (D22/20173) dated 24 February 2022 that “Sell & Parker confirms that SSD 10396 will not make any changes to the fire vehicle access or manoeuvrability during active operational hours”. FRNSW are satisfied that the proponent intends to maintain access and manoeuvrability for FRNSW vehicles during active operational hours.

FRNSW note the response from the proponent that “Sell & Parker have further contacted FRNSW to discuss the Stockpile Plan, both directly (24 February 2022) and via the planning portal (15 March 2022). No response has been received to date. It is noted that the Stockpile Plan provided to FRNSW is the plan which has been approved by LEC Proceeding 2020/00365487 which has previously been reviewed and approved by FRNSW.” FRNSW refer to our correspondence (D22/21933) dated 23 March 2022 and uploaded to the Planning Portal on this same date. A copy of this original letter will be uploaded to the Planning Portal again to accompany this new letter.
