Dear Giles,

Thank you for your referral dated 12 July 2022, in relation to the Eastern Creek REP Throughput Increase (SSD-11606719) (Blacktown), Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Aboriginal Cultural Heritage (ACH). Heritage NSW makes the following comments.

I note that in relation to this proposal, Heritage NSW has been consulted by the applicant with respect to the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) issued by the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) in December 2020, and updated in April, September and October 2021, in relation to the requirement that an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment (ACHAR) be prepared for the proposal. Based on consultation with Heritage NSW and the information provided in Appendix Q of the EIS, I can advise that the preparation of an ACHAR in this instance, is not required. This advice is based on the information documented in previous assessments, as well as the demonstrated high levels of land use disturbance, present across the proposed development footprint. No further assessment with respect to Aboriginal cultural Heritage is required, and as such, Heritage NSW does not need to review or be consulted in relation to this project in the future.
