Context

TfNSW notes for this SSD:

- The key state road is Five Islands Road and Old Port Road.
- The NSW Department of Environment and Planning is seeking advice from TfNSW to assist in its assessment of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).
- The development proposes a bulk liquid storage facility, with associated pipelines and builds [as set out in Attachment 2].
- The proponent has identified that during construction and operation, heavy vehicles will have the option of approaching and departing the site via Five Islands Road and Darcy Road. A turn path assessment was completed for the approach/departure over the existing bridge on Darcy Road (see Attachment 3), which indicated that two opposing B-Double vehicles may not be able to pass over the bridge simultaneously. To ensure the ongoing safe and efficient operation of the surrounding state and local road network the below condition is to be included in the development consent.

Condition

1. All heavy vehicle access to the site is to be via the intersection of Five Islands Road and Flinders Street as follows:
 - a) Arrival to the site: From Five Islands Road turn left (approaching from the west) or right (approaching from the south) onto Flinders Street. Follow Flinders Street through to Old Port Road and then turn right into Foreshore Road to arrive at the site.
 - b) Departure from the site: Leave the site from Foreshore Road and turn right onto Old Port Road. Follow Old Port Road to Flinders Street and then turn left/right onto Five Islands Road.
