Kurri Kurri Lateral Pipeline Project (SSI-22338205). our ref: EBA22-00104

This letter provides Subsidence Advisory NSW's comments on the above project.

Sections of the proposed gas pipeline route are located within a declared mine subsidence district, and in areas where significant and varying subsidence risks have been identified.

Subsidence Advisory NSW have advised APA group at a meeting 22 June 2021 that a sufficiently detailed geotechnical investigation is required to determine the type and level of risk present, and appropriate engineering controls required to mitigate each identified risk.

APA group provided Subsidence Advisory with three desktop geotechnical assessments for our review on 31 October 2022 and have indicated an investigation drilling program is currently being carried out.

Subsidence Advisory NSW will be able to provide advice on conditions of consent for the project following our review and acceptance of the above. APA group have indicated that they intend to submit the relevant geotechnical assessment reports that incorporate borehole investigation results sometime in early December.
