Parramatta Metro Over Station Development (SSD 35538829) No Comment on Environmental Impact Statement

Dear Mr Groundwater

I refer to your invitation to the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) to provide on the Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed Sydney Olympic Park Over and Adjacent Station Development.

On 4 February 2022, the EPA wrote to the Department of Planning and Environment advising that no further consultation on this proposal was required.

The proposal's supporting documentation includes a Contamination Report. The EPA understands that <u>State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021</u> requires assessment of potential land contamination resulting from past land-use to determine whether the land is suitable for its proposed use or will require remediation. Under section 60 of the *Contaminated Land Management Act* (1997), the EPA must be notified of any contamination that meets certain triggers. These are outlined in the <u>Guidelines on the duty to report contamination under the Contaminated Land Management Act 1997.</u>
