**Subject:** Winterbourne Wind Farm (SSD-10471) – Environmental Impact Statement

Thank you for the opportunity to provide advice on the above matter. This is a response from the Department of Regional NSW – Mining, Exploration & Geoscience (MEG) – Geological Survey of NSW (GSNSW).

MEG-GSNSW has reviewed the Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed Winterbourne Wind Farm and notes Exploration Licence (EL) 9338, held by Iolanthe Minerals Pty Ltd, overlaps the far northern portion of the proposed Winterbourne Wind Farm project. As required by the SEARs, the proponent (Winterbourne Wind Pty Ltd) must consult with the holders of all current mineral title that overlap the project area. If not already undertaken MEG-GSNSW requests that consultation takes place with Iolanthe Minerals.
