

Daroobalgie Solar Farm

The Department of Planning and Environment – Crown Lands has reviewed the proposal.

The proposal includes the construction of power infrastructure - poles and a 132kV transmission line - on a 45m wide power easements, which are located on a number of Crown parcels identified below.

- Lot 1664 DP 750158 Reserve 16839,
- Lot 7003 DP 1060435 Reserve 16839, and
- Crown road directly south of Lot 131 DP 1272667

In order for transmission lines to traverse Crown land and roads, the proponent will need to apply for easements. This land may need to be acquired under the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991* (LATJC Act) or apply to acquire an easement under the *Crown land management Act 2016*.

As the easement process may be lengthy, it is also recommended that the proponent apply for a licence for each Crown road and Crown land lot as soon as possible. A licence will temporarily authorise use and access for the infrastructure to traverse Crown roads and Crown land whilst the easement applications are being processed.

It is important to note that licences or easements must be in place before infrastructure can traverse Crown land or roads.

During the assessment of your proposal, it was noted that Native Title has not been extinguished on the subject land and that the proposal will require a suitable pathway under the *Commonwealth Native Title Act 1993* (NTA1993) to authorise the above easements or Crown land licence. 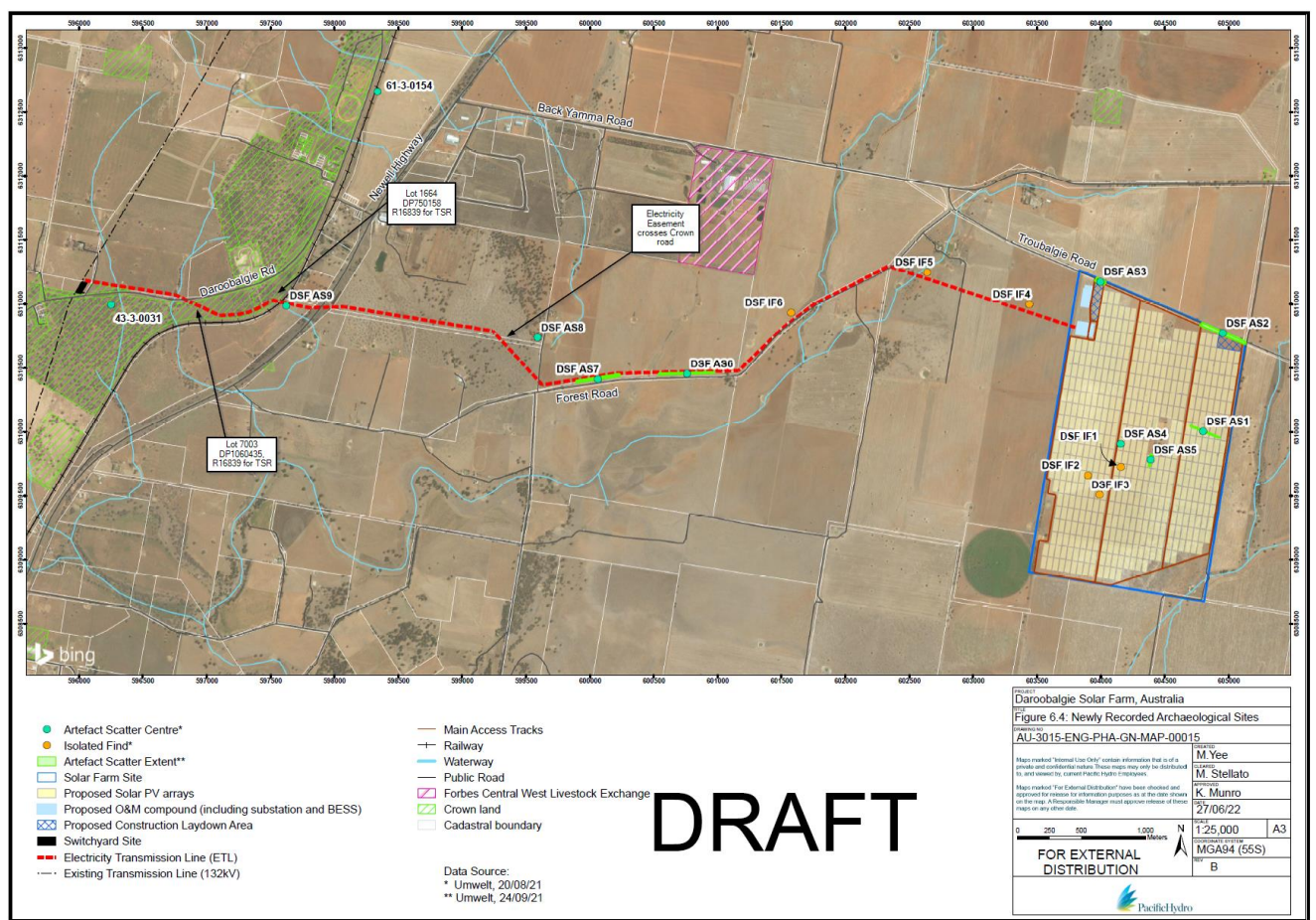


Diagram1: Map supplied by the client with Crown land details annotated
