Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) acknowledge correspondence received on the 10 February 2023, requesting advice on the EIS for NARWEE PARKLANDS SENIORS HOUSING – 59-67 KARNE STREET NORTH, NARWEE (SSD- 45024776). FRNSW have reviewed the EIS along with Appendix M – BCA Report and Appendix X – Hazardous Materials Survey.
