Construction Pedestrian and Management Plan (CTPMP)

Comment:

TfNSW notes that the proposed development construction has the potential to impact the surrounding classified road network.

Recommendation:

TfNSW recommends that Department includes the following condition in any determination issued:

A preliminary Construction Traffic and Pedestrian Management Plan should be prepared in consultation with Council and TfNSW to demonstrate the proposed management of construction related traffic, which addresses the following:

- o Assessment of cumulative impacts associated with other construction activities (if any).
- An assessment of road safety at key intersection and locations subject to heavy vehicle construction traffic movements and high pedestrian activity.
- Details of construction program detailing the anticipated construction duration and highlighting significant and milestone stages and events during the construction process.
- o Details of anticipated peak hour and daily construction vehicle movements to and from the site.
- Details of on-site car parking and access arrangements of construction vehicles, construction workers to and from the site, emergency vehicles and service vehicle.
- Details of temporary cycling and pedestrian access during construction.
