Wallerawang Power Station- Ash Dam Modification 2 (MP07_0005-Mod 2)- Advice on Modification Report

I refer to your email received 9 June 2023 in regard to the Wallerawang Power Station- Ash Dam Modification 2 (MP07_0005-Mod 2)- Advice on Modification Report.

Council notes that the development proposes to amend Condition 2.36A(e) on the consent for an additional 10 years. Condition 2.36A(e) states:

Capping Material Transport Impacts

2.36A The Proponent must: (e) not import capping material to the site for more than 2 years following its commencement.

Council considers the Environmental Assessment adequately highlights the relevant issues, and has no objection to the modification project subject to the following original conditions remaining on the consent:

Capping Material Transport Impacts

2.36A The Proponent must:

(a) not import more than 100 heavy vehicle loads of capping material to the site per day; (b) cover all heavy vehicle loads of capping material;

(c) not transport capping material on local roads in the Lithgow local government area;

(d) notify the Department before commencing the importation of capping material from sources outside of the Lithgow local government area; and

2.36B The Proponent must implement warning signage on the Castlereagh Highway on the approaches to the Castlereagh Highway/Wallerawang Power Station Haul Road intersection prior to importing capping material to the site from sources outside of the Lithgow local government area to the satisfaction of RMS.
