Dear Lauren,

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) refers to your correspondence dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2019 regarding the above development application.

RMS has completed an assessment of the DA, based on the information provided and focussing on the impact to the state road network. RMS notes for this DA:

- The key state road is the Hume Highway;
- RMS response dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2019 (Attachment 1) following submission of the Environmental Impact Statement.

Having regard for the above, RMS has reviewed the SIDRA modelling provided and the associated Response To Submissions (RTS) report dated September 2019 and is satisfied that it addresses the requirements in RMS response dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2019. In relation to the possible future provision of traffic signals at Marulan South Road, RMS involvement would only be required if the proposed signals are on a public road/roadway open to the public.
