Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) acknowledge correspondence received on the 17 July 2024, requesting advice on the EIS for DINAWAN WIND FARM (SSD-50725708). FRNSW have reviewed the EIS with particular focus to Section 3 Project Description and Appendix E.13 Hazards and Risks.

It is deemed that the proposal has limited scope and application in regard to special hazards or special problems of firefighting. FRNSW submit no comments or recommendations for consideration, nor any requirements beyond that specified by applicable legislation.
