Modification advice for Cullen Valley Modification 5 - Extension of Life (DA200-5-2003) (Cullen Valley Modification 5 (DA200-5-2003-Mod-5))

Dear Melanie,

Thank you for your referral dated 5 March 2025 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development (SSD) proposal.

The following report was considered in our assessment:

- Cullen Valley Mine DA 200-5-2003 Modification 5 Report- prepared by EMM, dated January 2025

The proposed development involves:

- Modification of the approved project boundary to include a small adjacent area to utilise existing water infrastructure
- Extension of the mine life for another 5 years (until August 2030)

Heritage NSW understands that the proposed modification will not require any additional surface disturbance activities beyond those currently assessed and approved.

No SHR items, or items of historical heritage significance are located within the current project, or proposed modification boundary.
