Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) acknowledge correspondence received on 11 May 2025, requesting advice on the Amendment Report for BLOOMFIELD COLLIERY CONTINUATION PROJECT MODIFICATION 5 (MP07_0087-MOD-5). FRNSW have reviewed the Amendment Report with particular focus to Section 7.3 Hazards and risks.

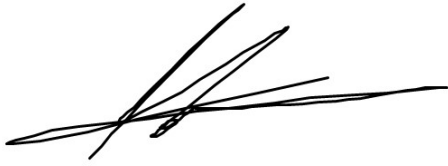
The Modification Report details dangerous goods which are listed as being used, handled or stored at the Colliery in quantities that exceed manifest quantities stipulated by Schedule 11 of the WHS Regulation 2017.

It has been the experience of FRNSW that dangerous goods facilities present special problems of fighting fire and suitable additional provisions are likely to be required in accordance with E1D17 and E2D21 of the National Construction Code 2022¹. FRNSW therefore recommend the following conditions:

1. Prior to occupation or commissioning an Emergency Plan (EP) is developed for the site in accordance with HIPAP No.1².
2. Prior to occupation or commissioning an Emergency Services Information Package (ESIP) is developed for the site in accordance with FRNSW fire safety guideline – Emergency services information package and tactical fire plans³.
