Thank you for your referral seeking advice on the above State Significant Development proposal.

In preparing this advice Heritage NSW has reviewed the following documents:

- Relevant sections of Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) DHL Logistics Facility (North) – prepared by Urbis, dated 24 March 2025
- HMS ID 7874 HNSW Advice on EIS Burrah Park SSD-70316465 – prepared by Heritage NSW, dated 12 December 2024
- Appendix P Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Letter SSD-70817958 – prepared by Artefact Heritage, dated 2 October 2024

Heritage NSW notes that a previous application (SSD-70316465) submitted for exhibition in December 2024 comprises a proposed Masterplan and Stage 1 Concept of the Burra Park area, and that the current application (SSD-70817958) assumes approval of the Masterplan to inform its assessment of Aboriginal cultural heritage. We further note that, following review of the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report (ACHAR) submitted for the Masterplan, Heritage NSW provided a Response to Submissions (RtS) letter (HMS 7874) requesting additional information to inform our advice to the Department on whether the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements

(SEARs) for the project have been met. To date, this additional information remains outstanding, and the Masterplan (SSD-70316465) has not been approved.

With the above in mind, Heritage NSW requests the following information to inform its advice to the Department on whether the SEARs for the current project (SSD-70817958) have been met:

- Please provide confirmation that the additional information requested in relation to the Masterplan application (SSD-70316465) outlined in HMS 7874 have been met to the satisfaction of Heritage NSW and the Department.
- Please provide confirmation of the approval of Masterplan (SSD-70316465).
- Please provide evidence of consultation with the Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs) identified during preparation of the ACHAR for Masterplan (SSD-70316465) to update them on the current project regarding the proposed site use and detailed design outlined in SSD-70817958.
