Attachment A - Recommended Draft Conditions for Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

Below are our recommended draft conditions for the protection of Aboriginal Heritage.

Aboriginal heritage

- 1. All reasonable steps must be taken to avoid harm, modification, or other impact to Aboriginal objects except as authorised by this approval.
- 2. The Registered Aboriginal Parties must be kept informed about the SSD. The Registered Aboriginal Parties must continue to be provided with the opportunity to be consulted about the Aboriginal cultural heritage management requirements of the SSD.
- 3. A procedure for the management of unexpected Aboriginal objects and human remains must be developed in consultation with the Registered Aboriginal Parties and Heritage NSW. The procedure must be prepared in accordance with Heritage NSW guidelines and codes of practice and must be implemented for the duration of the project.
- 4. Ensure workers on site receive suitable heritage inductions prior to carrying out any development on site, and that records are kept of these inductions.
