SSD-6764-Mod-3 – Request for Advice on Modification Report – Wilpinjong Coal Mine, Ulan-Wollar Road, Wollar

Dear Cherie,

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is responding to a request to provide advice on the modification to the Wilpinjong Coal Mine (SSD-6764-Mod-3), referred via the NSW Major Projects Portal on 1 October 2025.

TfNSW has reviewed the information submitted, including the ‘Road Transport Assessment’ and notes that the extent of the proposed modification will largely be contained to the local road network. Accordingly, TfNSW has no objections to the proposed modification.

It is noted that the affected local and classified (Regional) roads are maintained by Council as both the asset manager and roads authority under the *Roads Act 1993*. TfNSW advises that consultation should be undertaken with Mid-Western Regional Council to ensure the management measures, performance indicators and other risk assessment items are suitable and in accordance with the conditions of consent, any existing strategies, and relevant statutory requirements.

TfNSW reserves the right, as a roads authority to request information relating to traffic management in the event of any substantial impacts to Ulan Road (MR214) or Wollar Road (MR208) that would result in safety and/or operational concerns for both operational mine traffic and road users on the broader transport network.
