Thank you for providing Transport for NSW (**TfNSW**) an opportunity to comment on the Exhibition of Environmental Impact Statement (**EIS**) for the proposed mixed-use development at 15A & 15B Moseley Street and 25-31 Donald Street, Carlingford. TfNSW has reviewed the submitted EIS and advises that:

- The traffic generation comparison between the previous Development Approval (**Approval**) and this development results in an increase of 7 additional vehicle trip during weekday commuter peak periods. As such, the traffic generated will unlikely have an impact on the surrounding transport network.
- No civil works are proposed on the classified road network, as such all civil works proposed on the local road network should be undertaken to the satisfaction of Council as the relevant Road Authority.

As such, TfNSW provide the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (**DPHI**) with suggested conditions of consent in **TAB A** for consideration.

Construction Pedestrian Traffic Management Plan

Recommended condition:

A Construction Pedestrian Traffic Management Plan (CPTMP) detailing construction vehicle routes, number of trucks, hours of operation, access arrangements and traffic control should be submitted to TfNSW for review and endorsement prior to the issue of a construction certificate.

To ameliorate impact of construction activities on the surrounding transport network.

Green Travel Plan

Recommended Condition:

As part of the ongoing operation of the development, a detailed Green Travel Plan (GTP), which includes target mode shares to reduce the reliance on private vehicles, shall be prepared. The GTP must be implemented accordingly and updated annually.

Reason:

To encourage and support sustainable transport outcomes for future users of the development.
