### **EPA Advice on Gerroa Quarry Modification Application – MP05\_0099 (MOD 2)**

I refer to Modification Application MP05\_0099 (MOD 2) (Application) made by RW Corkery & Co on behalf of Regional Quarries & Concrete Pty Ltd, trading as Cleary Bros (Proponent) for the premises located at Beach Road, Gerroa NSW (Premises). The Proponent holds Environment Protection Licence 4146 (Licence) issued under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* in relation to the scheduled activities of crushing, grinding or separating and other extractive activities undertaken at the Premises.

The EPA understands the Proponents:

- Seeks to increase the transportation rate by 50% from 80,000 tonnes per annum to 120,000 tonnes per annum by increasing the proportion of larger vehicles.
- Does not suggest further changes to approved operations. Specifically, no changes are proposed to the currently approved extraction footprint.

The EPA has reviewed the Application and advises the following:

#### **Environment Protection Licence Limits**

The Licence limits “Extractive activities” and “Crushing, grinding or separating” activities at the Premises to 100,000 tonnes per annum. If the Application is approved by Planning, the Proponent will need to make a separate application to the EPA to vary the Licence and increase this limit.
