Hunter Expressway (6011) is a Freeway, parts of Northcote Street and Mitchell Avenue form sections of MR588 a classified (State) road, Hart Road is a classified (Regional) road, Styles Street, Mitchell Avenue (fronting the development) and Government Road are local roads. TfNSW is the Roads Authority for Freeways. Council is the roads authority for all other public roads in the area, in accordance with Section 7 of the *Roads Act 1993*.

TfNSW has reviewed the information provided and has no requirements for the proposed development as it is considered there will be no significant impact on the nearby classified (State) road network.
