**Proposed State Significant Development (DA80/10060-MOD10) – Modification to Water Management, Mt Piper Power Station-Advice on Modification Report**

Reference is made to the proposed State Significant Development (DA80/10060-MOD10) Mt Piper Power Station Water Management System-Advice on Modification Report.

The modification relates to:

- Increasing the capacity of the Coal Settling Pond (CSP);
- Construction and use of multipurpose water storage ponds;
- Development of pollution control structures (PCS); > Addition of a soil stabilising agent to stockpiled coal; and
- An administrative amendment to align the annual Environmental Monitoring reporting period with the financial year.

No changes to any other aspect of the approved MPPS operations are proposed.

Council considers the modification mitigation/enhancement strategies will help to improve water management at the Power Station and as such has no objection to the application subject to Council's original and previous conditions remaining on the consent.
