Dear Ms. Fishburn,

Thank you for providing Transport for NSW (**TfNSW**) an opportunity to comment on the exhibition of Environmental Impact Statement (**EIS**) for the proposed Sludge Dewatering Plant at long Street, Smithfield.

TfNSW has reviewed the submitted EIS and advises the Department of Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure (**DPHI**) that:

- The development proposes vehicle access for the plant from Long Street (**local road**) and exit onto Tait Street (**local road**). TfNSW advises that as Council is the relevant Road Authority for Long Street and Tait Street, Council should be satisfied with the design, layout and proposed access arrangement including swept path movement for the largest vehicle.
- The development's estimated traffic generation daily trips (**125 vehicles into the subject site, 125 vehicles out of the subject site**) will unlikely have a detrimental impact on the surrounding classified road network.

As such, TfNSW has no further comment.
