Thank you for providing Transport for NSW (**TfNSW**) an opportunity to comment on the Exhibition of Environmental Impact Statement (**EIS**) for the proposed upgrades to recycling centre at 13 Bellfrog Street, Greenacre.

TfNSW has reviewed the EIS and advises the Department of Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure (**DPHI**) that:

- The development proposes vehicle access and civil works to Bellfrog Street (**local road**).

Bellfrog Road is a local road under the care and control of Council who is the relevant Road Authority.

As such, Council should be satisfied with the design, layout and proposed access arrangement including swept path movements of the development as the relevant Road Authority.

- The development proposes an increase of 50 vehicle trips generated per hour, which will unlikely impact the surrounding transport and classified road network.

As such, TfNSW has no further comments on the EIS.
