Oberon Quarries gained development consent in 1993. The quarry is located on Racecourse Hill approx. 4 km south of Oberon. In 2015 the quarry gained approval (SSD_6333) to increase maximum production to 400000 tpa and continue operations until 2045. Oberon quarries is no seeking to extend quarry operations to an adjoining 32.3 ha site quarry to access an additional 12.6 Mt of basalt resource. Quarry is seeking to increase production to 950000 tpa and to backload ENM and VENM to the site.
